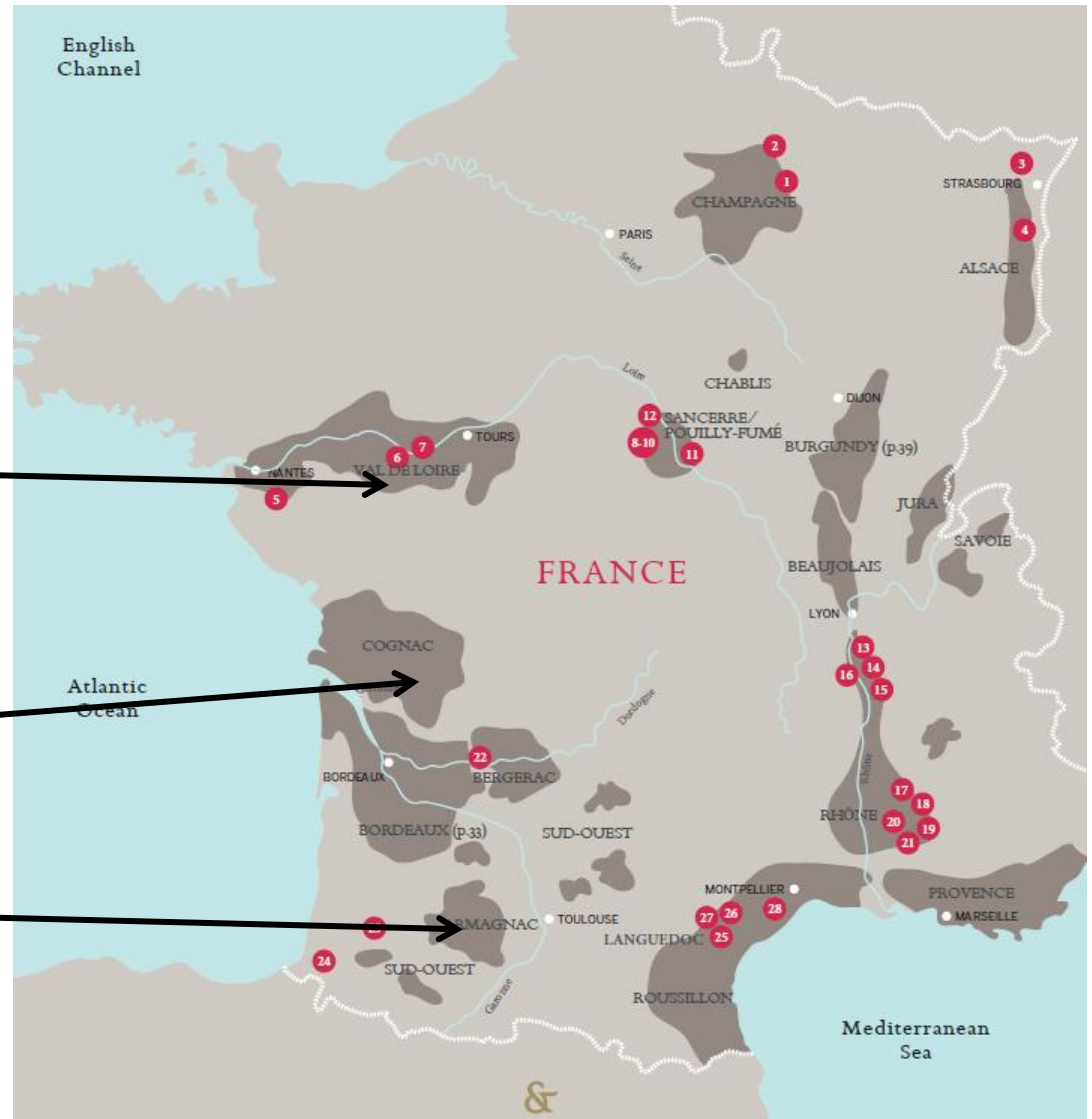
The own-label range

Varichon et Clerc

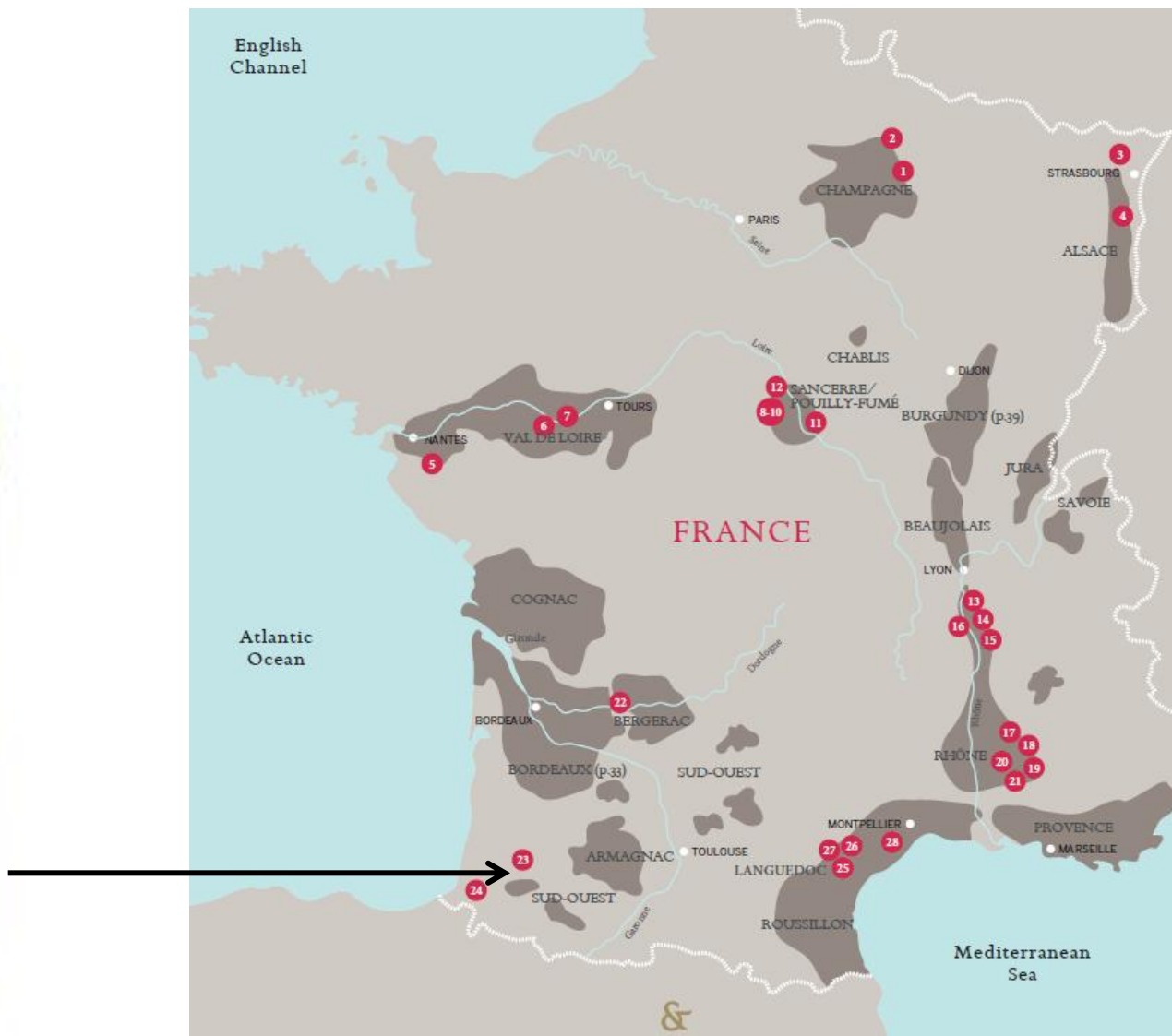

Expanding into Burgundy and the Cerdon appellation in eastern France, they were themselves snapped up as part of the Boisset group and continue to make high-quality sparkling wine from grapes sourced across France

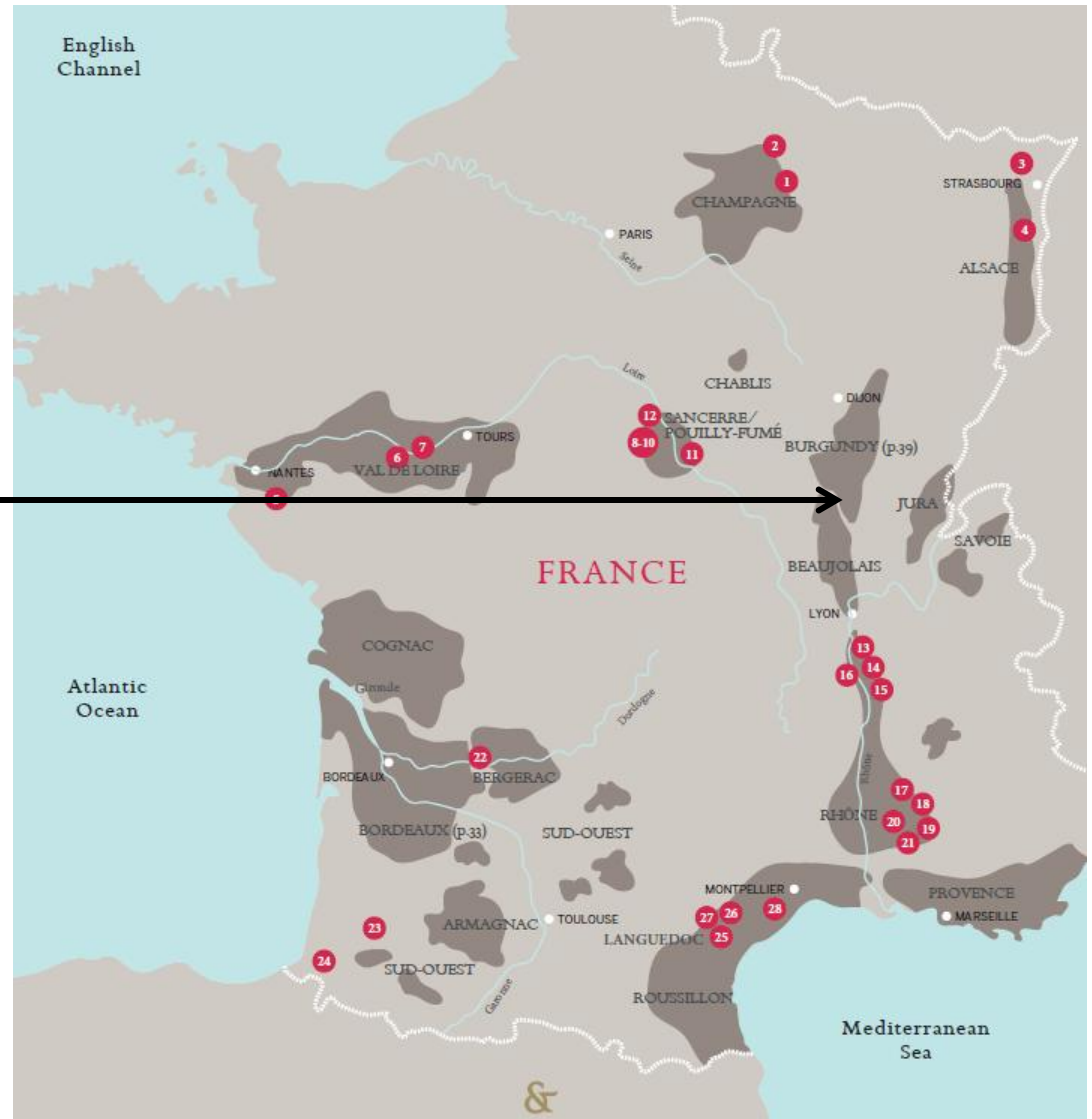
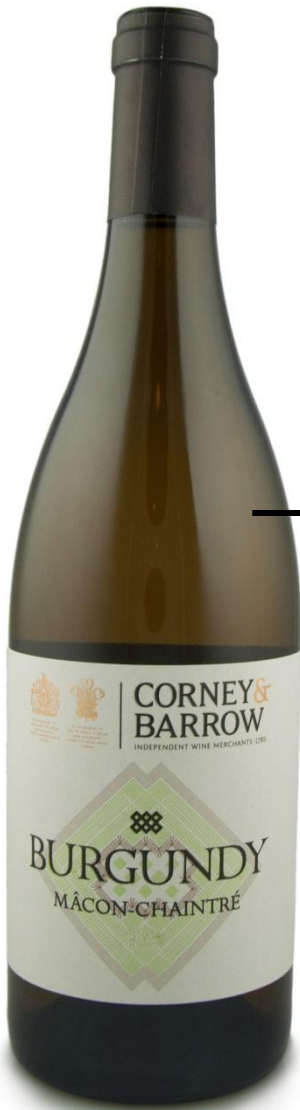
Producteurs Plaimont

Plaimont are an innovative co-operative who have almost single-handedly revived the rich viticultural history of Gascony. Since 1979, they have invested hugely in technology to increase quality, revitalised local grape varieties and transformed the landscape using sustainable viticultural methods.

Keen to have a social role as well as an economic one, every single grower under the Plaimont umbrella is involved in decision making processes and invited to take part in wider company marketing initiatives.

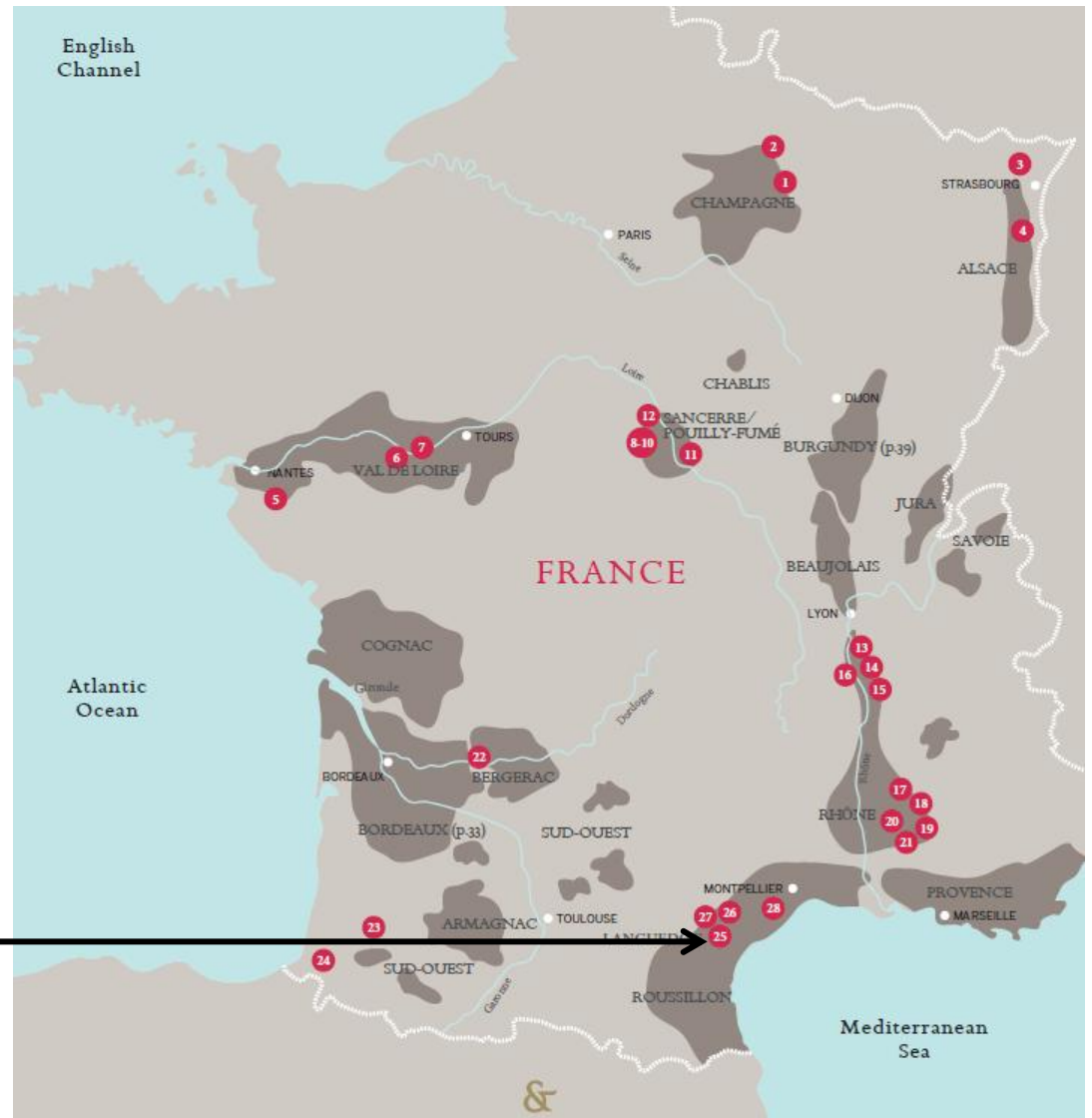
Domaine Cornin

Run by father and son team Dominique and Romain, Domaine Cornin is a tiny, family-owned estate of 10 hectares around the village of Chaintré in southern Burgundy. Much like most of the Maçonnais, the wines here are generous, ripe and rounded, with a pronounced mineral streak.

Certified organic and working to biodynamic principles, respect for nature and working with the environment is at the very heart of this estate's ethos.

Celliers Jean d'Alibert

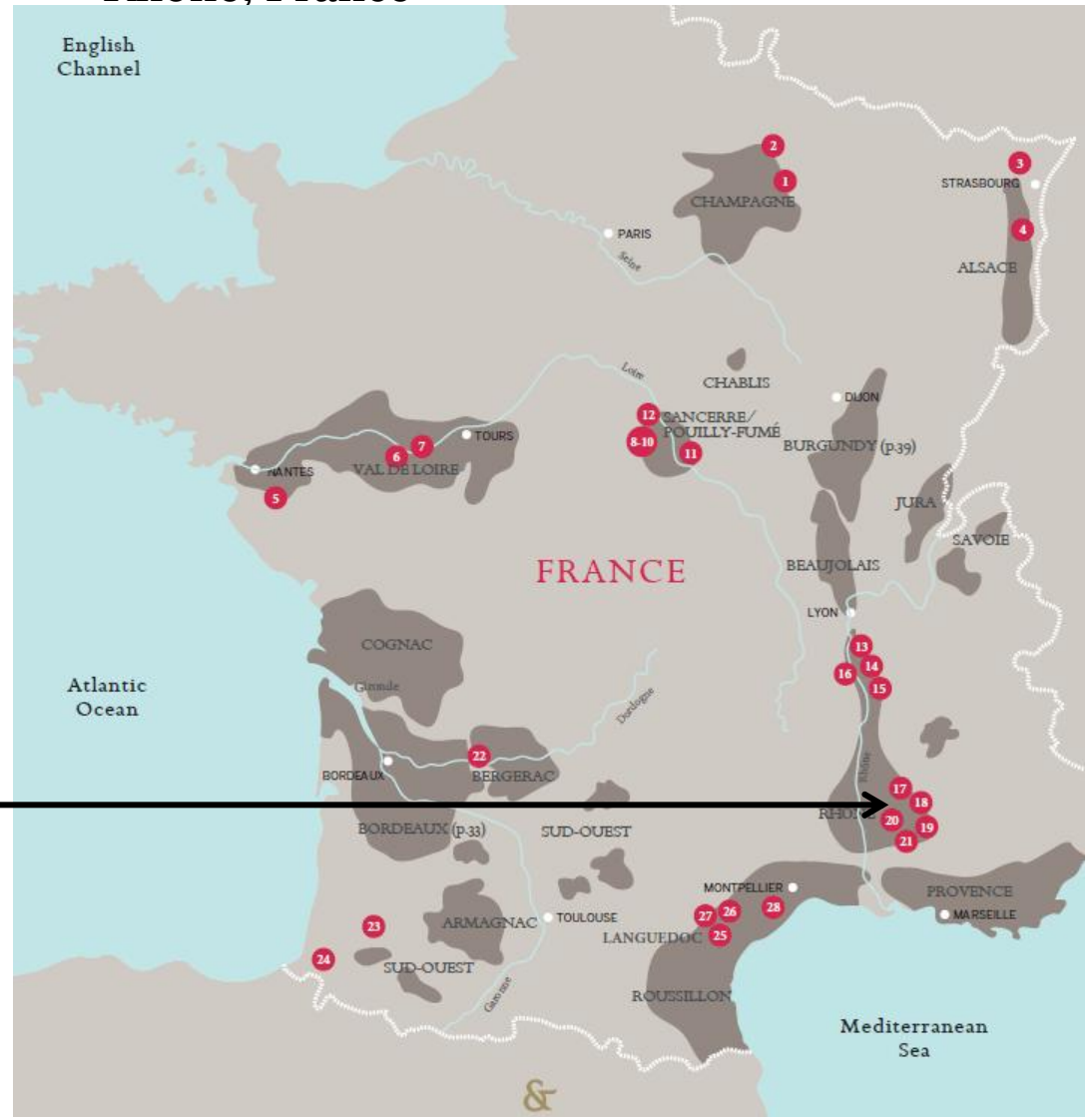

Their jewel in the crown is their diversity of *terroir*, including some notable pre-phyloxeric vineyards, and this gives them access to a wide variety of different qualities, varieties and styles.

Run by third generation winemakers Guillaume and Bertrand, this family estate has over 30 hectares of vineyards in the southern Rhône, including some right on the border of the famous Châteauneuf-du-Pape appellation and thus sharing much of the same soils.

Whilst there is plenty of the region's typical baked fruit and richness of structure, the wines of Gonnet are renown for their freshness and aromatic complexity; certainly amongst the most elegant wines in this area.

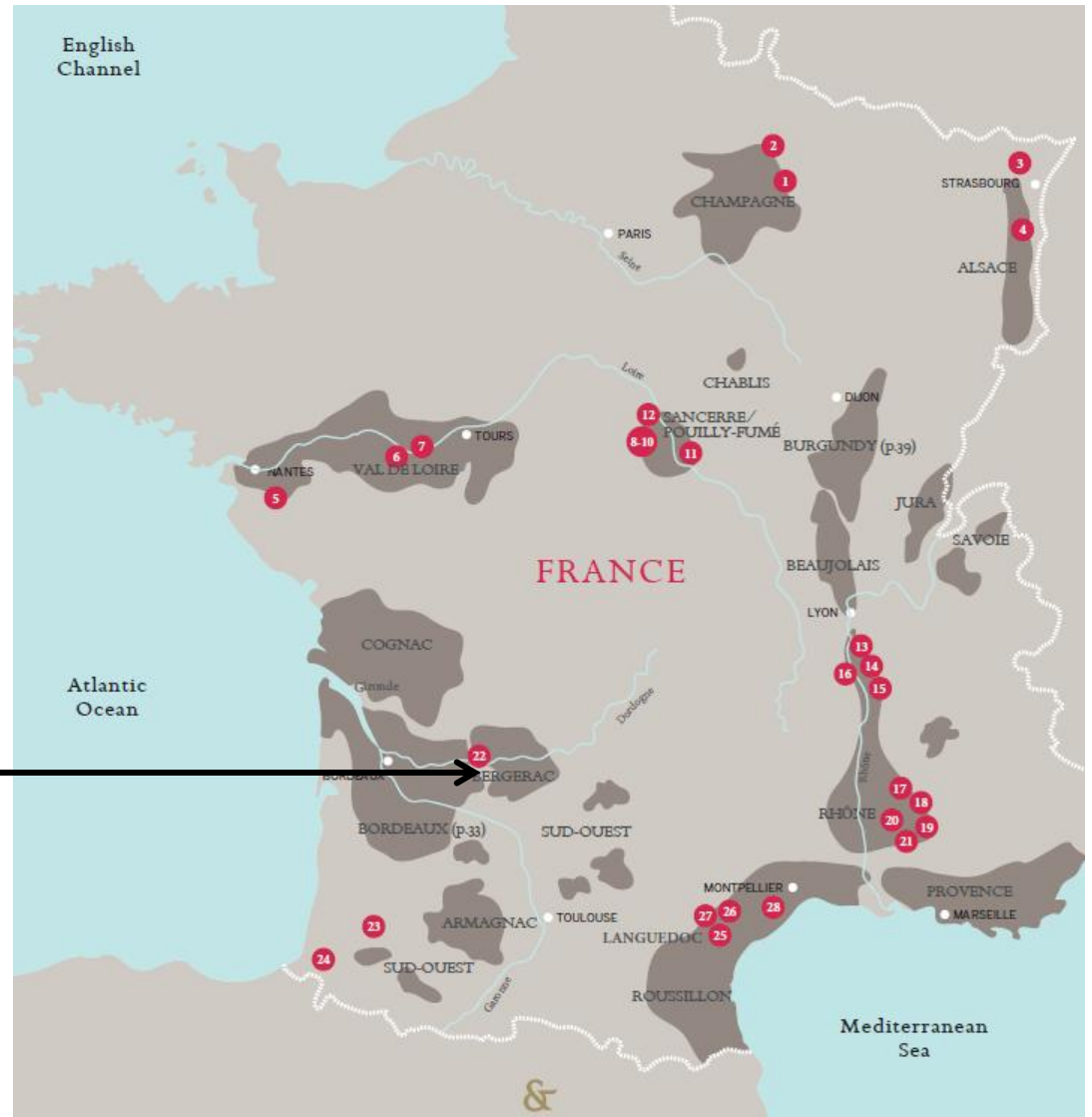
Bodegas Zugober

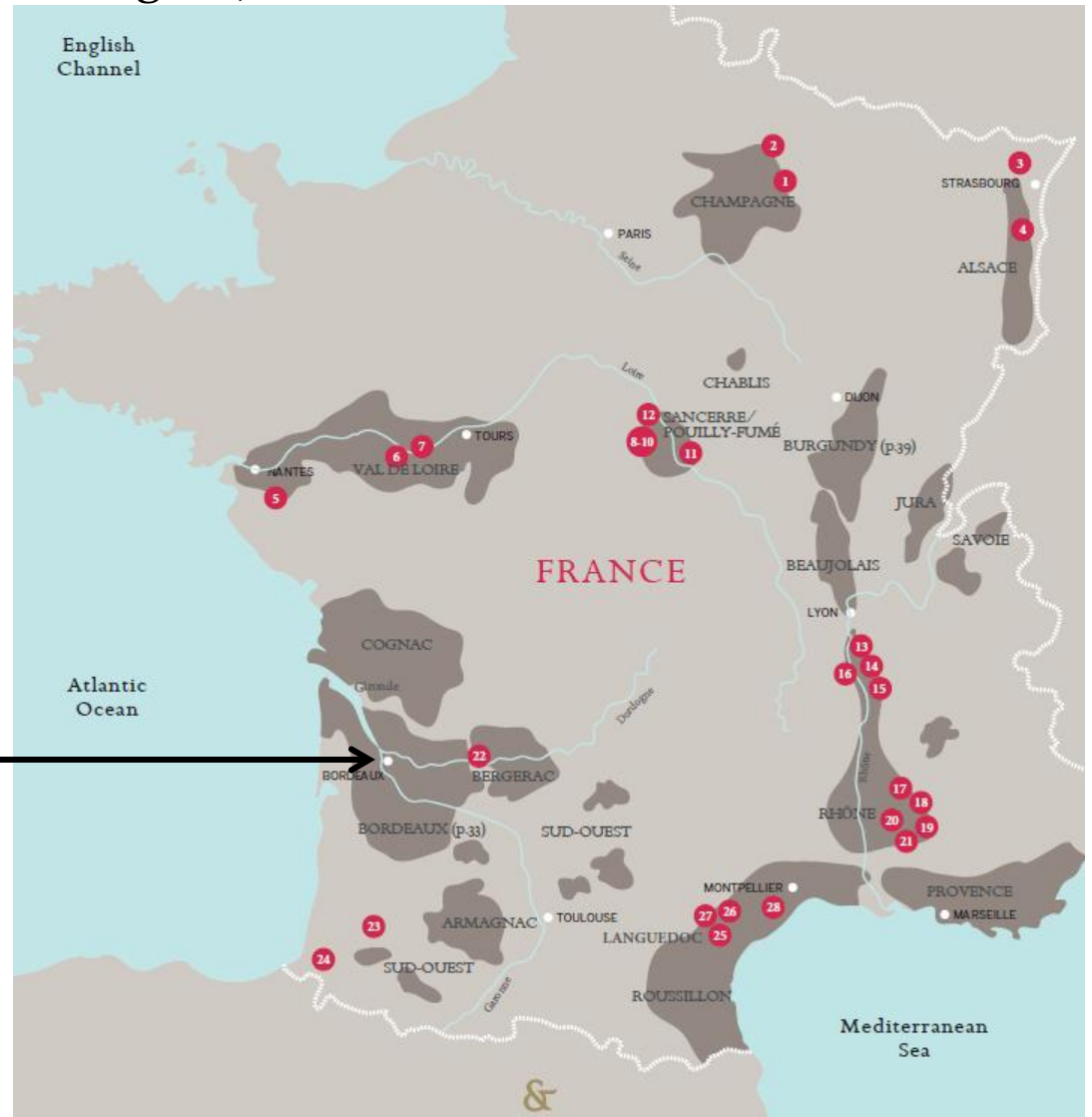
